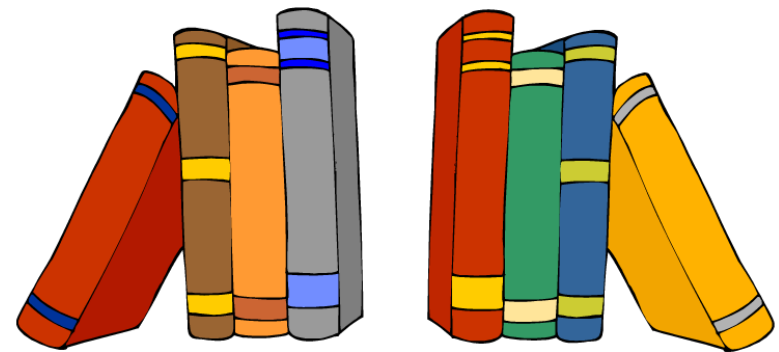

**206- BREAKING OUR SILENCE IN THE BLACK CHURCH: JESUS, JUSTICE AND THE HOLY SPIRIT**

**Course Description:** Can you answer these questions: Who am I? Who was I before slavery? Where is my origin? These questions will be addressed in the discovery of who we are as a people as we begin to be awakened.

**500- EXPRESSING YOUR THOUGHTS IN WRITING (Minister's only)**
